As I write this, it has been two weeks since the conclusion of the 2024 season at camp, and I've had time to reflect on the experiences of the summer. I am so thankful. Having returned from living abroad just two weeks before the start of Staff Training, I can honestly say that this was the best job to come back to. There is so much to love about camp. Some of my favorite moments were when I could quietly sit on the sidelines and simply take in the sounds of camp-laughter, conversations, and worship. Those who have experienced it will understand, and for those who haven't, I encourage you to come and experience it for yourself - Stepping Stones is always looking for volunteers!

This past summer, camp welcomed 258 campers, 33 staff members, 96

counsellors, and 38 cooks - a total of 425 people who shared in the 2024 camp experience! Throughout the summer, people would often ask me which week had been my favourite up to that point. Perhaps they were hoping I'd mention the week their child attended or the week they served. My answer, however, remained consistent: It was an "Ephesians 4:16" kind of summer. Paul's description of unity in the body of Christ perfectly sums it up: "from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love." Each week, new campers came, with eager minds and bright smiles, and new staff, cooks, and counsellors came with servant hearts and willing hands. And through it all, God was near, always working. In fact, He is still working, even as Stepping Stones prepares for Camp 2025. Praise the Lord!

As I bring my reflections on Camp 2024 to a close, there are so many people to thank. To everyone who made their way up the gravel driveway to our little camp in the mountains: thank you. Whether you were a parent handling drop-offs and pick-ups, a cook serving faithfully in the kitchen, a counselor who braved bunk beds, a staff member leading sacrificially, or a camper coming to grow in faith and display childlike trust in the Saviour-camp was richer because of you. To the community that held us in prayer throughout the summer, thank you. May we all continue to grow in love, for our God is truly good, all the time.
